







16 PEACE, JUSTICE AND STRONG INSTITUTIONS



As the commitment and active participation of youth is critical for the achievement of responsive, inclusive participatory and representative decision making at all levels, Centre for Policy Analysis (CPA) started a Youth Leadership Program to provide a leadership training to the youth. Starting in the year 2019, the program intends to help the youth to increase their leadership capacity by giving classes, mentorship and networking. The trainees was selected from all the six regions of Somaliland between the ages of 19 to 25. Inspired by the Yali leadership program, a seven days long extensive training helped those who have proven record of positive contributions. The program included one-week training in Har-

geisa while CPA hosted the trainees and provided accommodation, meals and transportation. The focus of the training was civic leadership. It consisted of class sessions with 14 civic leadership courses, site visits where participants got opportunity to visit the highest offices of the country like the Supreme Court where the youth leaders listened the leadership experience of the Chief Justice H.E. Adam Haji Ali and then asked questioned, also they visited Somaliland's Presidential Palace, where the youth leaders met the acting

president H.E. Abdirahman Ismail Saylaci and the asked him questions related to his office and shared their concern, also they visited the parliament where the youth leaders met the speaker of the house H.E. Bashe Mohamed Farah, and they discussed different issues related to parliament businesses to law making procedures and the upcoming elections including to approve the election bill in the House. Also the youth got opportunity to meet, a cabinet ministers like the Minister of Youth and Sports, The Minister of Parliamentary Relations, Deputy Minister of education, Deputy Minister of Planning, Deputy Minister of Foreign Affairs, Deputy Minister of Interior, Director General of Ministry of Information, Director General of Ministry of Religious Affairs, etc. and also they met the leaders of all political parties in Somaliland, including the Chairman of UCID Party, the Leader of Waddani Party and the Deputy Chair of Ruling Party of Kulmiye.

The objective of the program is to enhance the leadership capability and civic awareness in Somaliland by supporting the young leaders. This will create country's future leaders. This initiative is directly promoting youth inclusion in Somaliland, and to contribute the realization of SDG16.7
